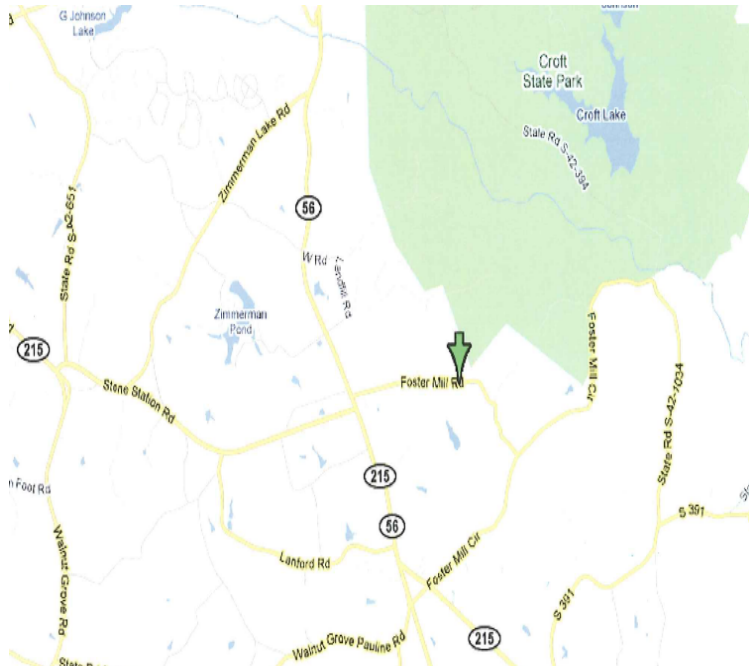


2010 Cub Scout Family Camp Out

Alcohol / Illegal Drugs / Tobacco Policy

The possession and/or use of alcohol, tobacco and illegal drugs are strictly prohibited on Camp premises and is against Camp ideals of providing safe and healthy environment for children. This includes being under the influence within the last 12 hours. Optimist acres is also a tobacco-free facility. This includes smoking, dipping and chewing.

Youth Protection Policy
